Dear Parents:

Despite the fact that Seville Intermediate School scored the highest designation of **Excellent** on the state report card for the 2010-11 school year, we are required by the state to send this letter to make you aware that the school has been listed in *School Improvement Status*. You are likely wondering how an **Excellent** school in an **Excellent** district could be in *School Improvement Status*. The reason is that the *School Improvement* designation is given to a building when it does not meet the state's goals in reading, mathematics or attendance for *two years in a row* in any of the ten student subgroups. In the case of Seville Elementary School, reading and math scores did not meet state goals in the students with disabilities subgroup.

You can now choose a free tutoring program that is best for your child. The district will provide assistance in selecting an approved provider, if requested. A list of approved tutoring programs that wish to offer free tutoring to your child can be viewed at <http://dnet01.ode.state.oh.us/ses/ProviderLookup.aspx>. Their programs have been approved by the Ohio Department of Education and will provide your child with tutoring that is coordinated with what is being taught here at Cloverleaf. The availability of this free tutoring may be limited.

Please understand that we as a district are committed to constant and permanent improvement. We have developed a comprehensive plan to help our students with disabilities perform at a higher level in reading and mathematics for the coming year. If you would like more information about the Supplemental Educational Services program (SES), please contact Seville Elementary School Principal Bob Falkenberg at 330-769-4672, or myself, Robert Hevener at 330-721-3503. Once you indicate your desire for free tutoring, you will receive a letter that indicates when the program will begin.
