## Cloverleaf High School Dance Rules

Part of our Mission Statement here at Cloverleaf is "Our students hold high expectations for themselves and their peers as they pursue a rigorous curriculum and exciting extra-curricular activities." Therefore, we expect students to uphold expectations in relation to their conduct at school dances.

To ensure that everyone has the opportunity to enjoy the dance, we will enforce the following rules:

- 1. The doors open and the dance will begin at 7:00. The last song of the night will begin at 10:55 p.m..
- 2. Once entering the school for the dance, students will not be permitted to leave at any point during the dance. Once you are inside the school, you may only go to your vehicle if you are escorted by a chaperone. This trip must be absolutely necessary.
- 3. All Cloverleaf High School rules and policies are in effect in terms of our policies and discipline regarding drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products.
- 4. Only one guest may attend with a Cloverleaf High School student. All guests must have a completed an approved guest form in order to attend. Middle school students may not attend high school dances.
- 5. Extremely promiscuous or sexually explicit dancing will not be tolerated. This includes but is not limited to touching of breasts or buttocks (or other private areas), "moshing," bending over, grabbing ankles or knees, straddling, or prolonged public displays of affection. Face to face dancing is preferred; students engaging in front to back dancing must remain <u>vertical/upright</u> and refrain from any vulgar or inappropriate moves. Students will receive one warning and take a 10-minute break upon a first violation of these rules. A subsequent violation will result in dismissal from the dance. There is to be no arguing with chaperones. Keep it Classy!
- 6. Shoes, coats, purses, and any other personal items may be placed in the designated area for storage during the dance.
- 7. Any disruption such as fighting, chanting, chanting of profanity, or willful disobedience of an adult chaperone will be handled on an individual basis and school discipline procedures will apply.
- 8. No Hats will be permitted without Administration approval.

Misbehavior by any individual will not be tolerated. Anyone unable to comply with the above policies could be asked to leave, have their parent or guardians contacted, and could result in disciplinary actions such as detention and/or suspension.
