## Student Wellness and Success Fund 2023-24

The Cloverleaf Local School District receives Student Wellness and Success Funds (SWSF) to fund initiatives to support wraparound services for Ohio's students. Districts must use at least 50% of these funds for mental health services and physical care services. The Cloverleaf Local School District allocates these funds to have a Prevention Coordinator at the each of our school buildings. These mental health professionals provide evidence-based treatment modalities, cognitive behavior strategies, and suicide prevention training, and assist students with substance abuse problems. Additionally, the district uses the SWSF for a nurse at each building. The nurses provide individual student support on a daily basis, maintain student health records, and provide student wellness information and support.
