- Ohio's death rate from accidental drug overdoses has jumped 37% since 1999.
- Heroin is flooding Ohio due to heightened demand. It costs less than prescription drugs and can be easier to obtain.

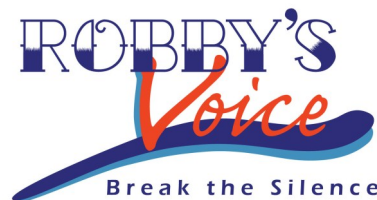
### What Differentiates Us
