

OPERATION: STREET SMART ADULT DRUG EDUCATION

The goal of Street Smart is to provide current and up-to-date narcotics information on trends, terminology, paraphernalia, concealment techniques, and physiological effects of drug use. The target audience for Street Smart includes D.A.R.E. and school resource officers, juvenile detectives, school administrators, school board members, teachers, counselors, juvenile probation officers, social workers, psychologists, parents and anyone working with young people. We will share with them the experience and knowledge of undercover narcotics officers so they are better prepared to help children make the right choices.

Dr. Jerry will present on prescription drug abuse and the opiate/heroin epidemic happening across the country, and particularly Northeast Ohio. He will address addiction as well as treatment issues, including medication assisted treatment.
